

PARK VIEW CIVIC LEAGUE MEETING MINUTES ~ A QUALITY NEIGHBORHOOD

JULY 19, 2010

I. Opening comments by President Tony Goodwin

Welcome of members and new neighbors given. Approval of minutes from May and June 2010 meetings.

II. Officer' s Reports/Committee Chair Reports

A. President' s Report - Tony Goodwin

The President informed members of Portsmouth being recognized as an Official Coast Guard City with celebrations to occur August 4th-8th. On August 5th the Chamber of Commerce will be holding their annual Seafood Outing. Street sweepers will clean our roads in approximately 1 ½ weeks.

B. Vice-President' s Report - Ian Raeburn

The Vice-President encouraged attendance, which is usually slower in summer months. He has been calling the police on some increased noise activity and invited members to contact him on any such occasion so that he may also call on their behalf; citing that multiple calls to the police increase the speed of responding on their part.

C. Secretary' s Report - Alycia Hemingway

The Secretary withheld report for discussion of Old Business.

D. Treasurer' s Report - Helen Edge

The Treasurer reported that the balance in our bank account was \$2,806.46. Dues are \$12 per year, and are good for membership until 12/31/10.

E. Traffic/Safety Report - Officer Baker

Officer Baker said that paving was underway at Effingham and Crawford intersection. Burglaries are up, but they caught someone today that may be responsible for multiple occurrences. The crab shack received eight indictments. Neighborhood gang is Parkview 95's, an offshoot of Oaks Mob which wears green bandanas. The President challenged membership to have someone step up and take the lead in beginning a Neighborhood Watch program within Parkview. Office Baker is still working with the Naval Hospital command on getting drivers to stop at the side exit of the post.

III. Guest Speakers

A. Pastor Britton

The Pastor let members know that the church sent out mailers to Parkview to express interest in serving the community. There will be an 11 on 11 community activity on September 11th at the church with a cookout afterwards (this is a partnership with another organization).
